It is vital that each Team has a responsible person to be Team Co ordinator, whose duty it is to collect Official Programmes for Players, ensure that all Officials are aware of their responsibilities (e.g. Umpires) and present themselves when required, and ensure that two goal umpires are available for each match and an Umpire's pony provided.

No Club may enter a Team unless its Affiliation Fees and all amounts owing to the NZ Polo Association have been paid in full and Player's Declarations have been received by the Association.

Attention is drawn to page 71 in the 2005 Rule Book regarding Player Eligibility to play in Savile Tournament.

“At least three players in a team entered by a Club must be financial playing members of that club, on that Club's list by 31 January and must be New Zealand citizens or hold New Zealand Passports. Any player residing permanently in New Zealand but holding a foreign Passport can apply to the Committee of Management prior to the closing of entries to be classed as a New Zealand player for Savile Tournaments.” “If the fourth member of the team is a current playing member of another club and on that Club's list at 31 January, written permission must be gained from both the club to which the player belongs, and the club for which he intends playing for at the Savile Tournament, before the entry can be accepted. If he is not a current playing member, a Declaration must be lodged with NZ Polo before he plays”
